

PANORA SPRING CLEAN-UP



The City of Panora will be conducting its annual **SPRING CLEAN-UP** on Saturday May 10 from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. All Panora residents are invited to drop off large waste items (no household garbage or toxic materials) on May 10 at the City's South Yard next to the salt shed at the end of SW 2nd Street. Residents should use this opportunity to clear their yards of all bulky waste, scrap metal, and broken furniture or appliances. Any of these items will be accepted at a cost of only \$5 per load (**Panora residents only - proof of residency required**). For an additional fee, tires from trucks (\$10) or cars (\$5) will also be accepted, as well as computers, monitors, and TVs for \$20 each. Besides the May 10th drop off day, residents may pay in advance to have refrigerators, water heaters (drained), ovens, dishwashers, clothes washers, and dryers picked up from their front curb on Thursday, May 8th at 8 a.m. for a cost of \$8 per appliance (no other items will be picked up at the curb). The City of Panora hopes this will help its residents with their spring cleaning efforts. For information call 755-2164.

Residents and property owners should be aware that if any waste is left out in yards after the Spring Clean-Up, they will, after proper notice of their requirement to abate (clean-up) a nuisance, receive a citation for being in violation of the City Code, and upon conviction, may be subject to a fine of up to \$500 or imprisonment up to 30 days.
